    - A cover page with your name and Project tile/number (i.e., Project 1b);
    - Paragraphs that describe (very *briefly*) the functionalities of your program;
    - The source (website, ...) of the program if it is not your code;
    - Special notices on how to compile/run the program;
    - In which environment you have run the program (OS, IDE...);
    - Results (and/or screenshots).
